

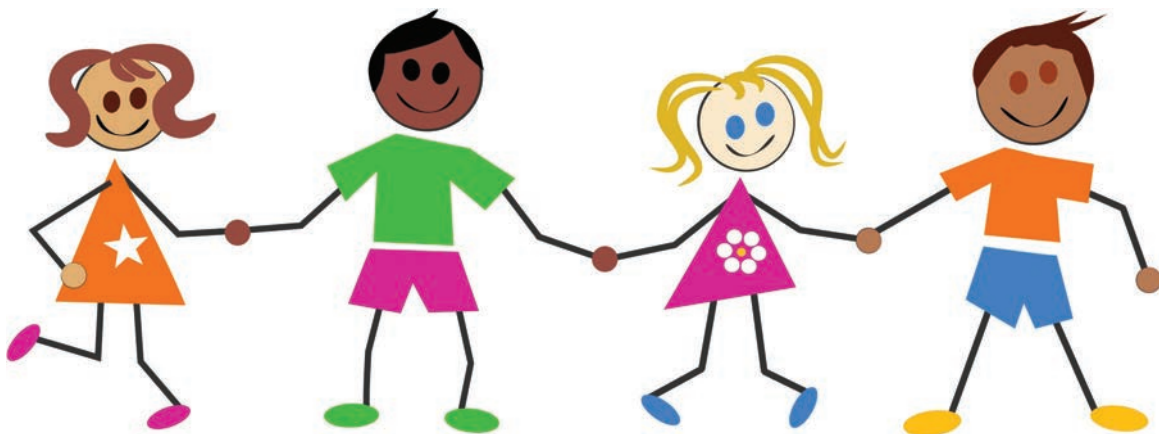

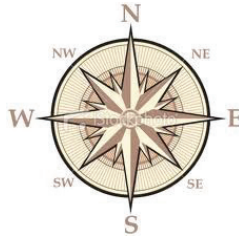

There are nine images on the next page. Copy these onto card-stock paper, and cut on the lines. Next, cut each image in half, separating them into two piles.

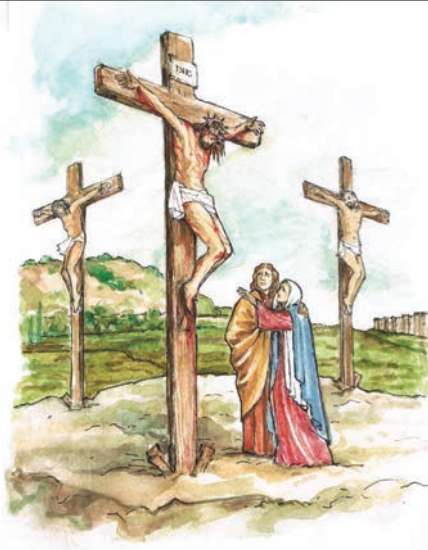
## *How to play:*

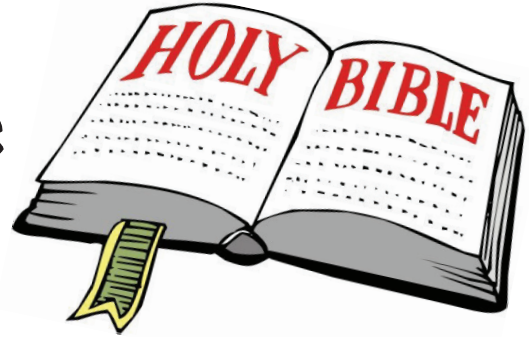
*Alternative:* You can make two copies of each image and have students play a matching game with them.

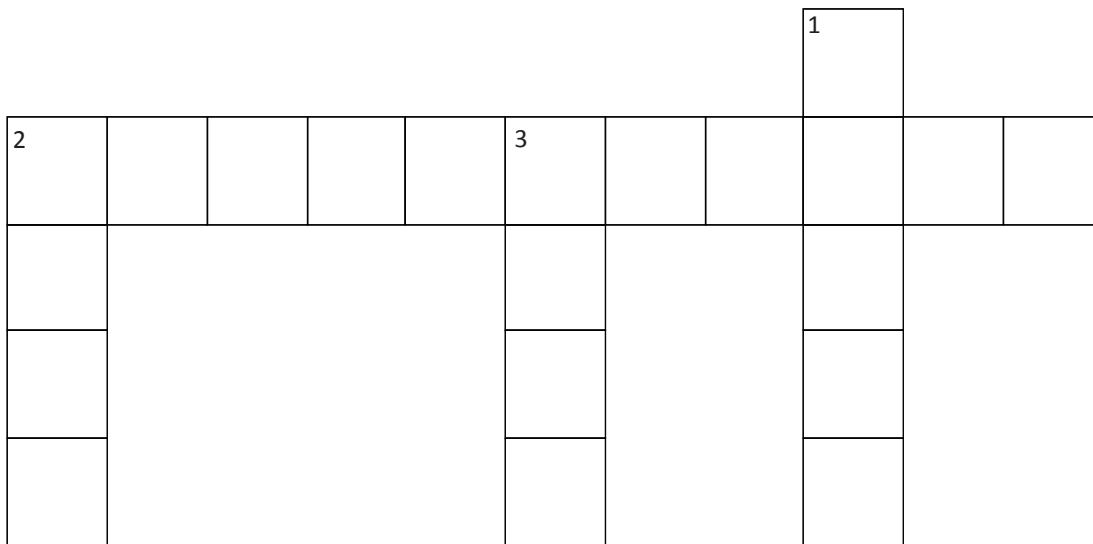


# Beatitudes Game
